

KYAZINAM FOUNDATION OUTREACH REPORT AT JJAJA FLORA'S ORPHANAGE

On 2024-May-01, our organization conducted a crucial outreach program at Jjaja Flora's Orphanage, home to forty-five (45) children, forty-three (43) of whom are actively enrolled in school, with two infants under Jjaja's care. The primary aim of the outreach was to deliver essential; food supplies and support to address the urgent needs of the orphanage.

During the outreach, we directly provided maize flour, sugar, rice, soap, and other vital provisions to alleviate the immediate needs of the children and the orphanage at large. Additionally, we engaged with the children, providing emotional support and encouragement, leaving a positive impact on their well-being.

The total cost of the supplies and provisions amounted to eight hundred thousand shillings, with our organization contributing four hundred thousand shillings towards the purchase. This ensured that orphanage received the necessary support to address the pressing needs of the children and the caretakers.

Jjaja Flora's Orphanage has been a pillar of hope and care for children since its establishment in 1986. We are committed to continuing our partnership with the orphanage to provide ongoing support and assistance.

Outreach outcome:
